Introduction to terms...

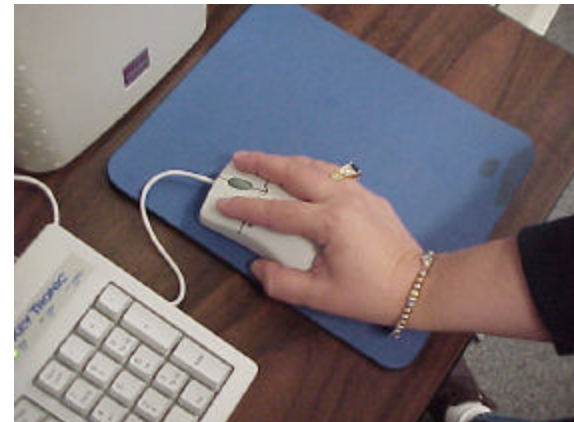
Holding the Mouse!

- Hold the mouse in the proper fashion, Gena will demonstrate with the picture to the right. This will allow optimum control!



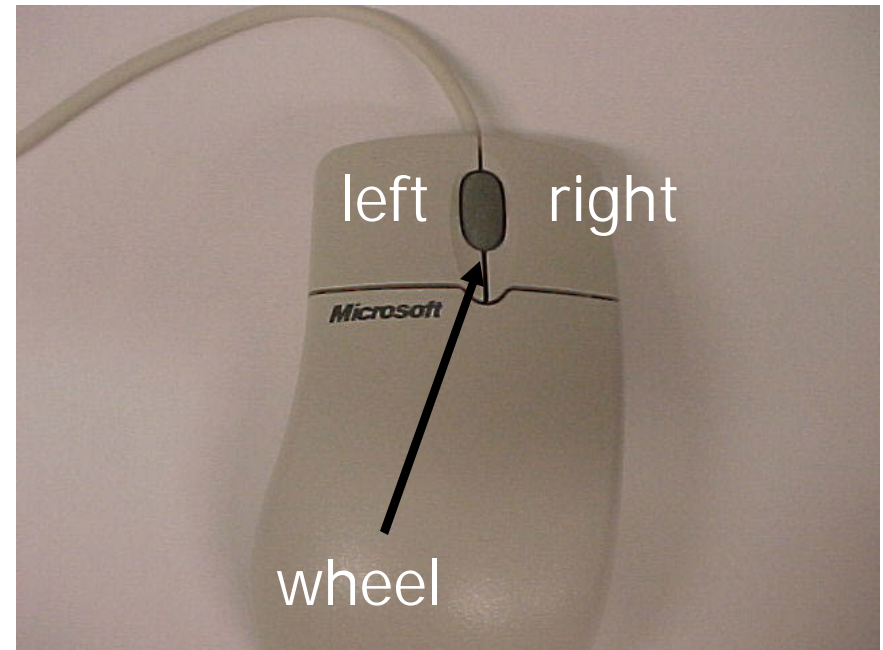
Moving the Mouse!

- The mouse has 2 buttons and the wheel.



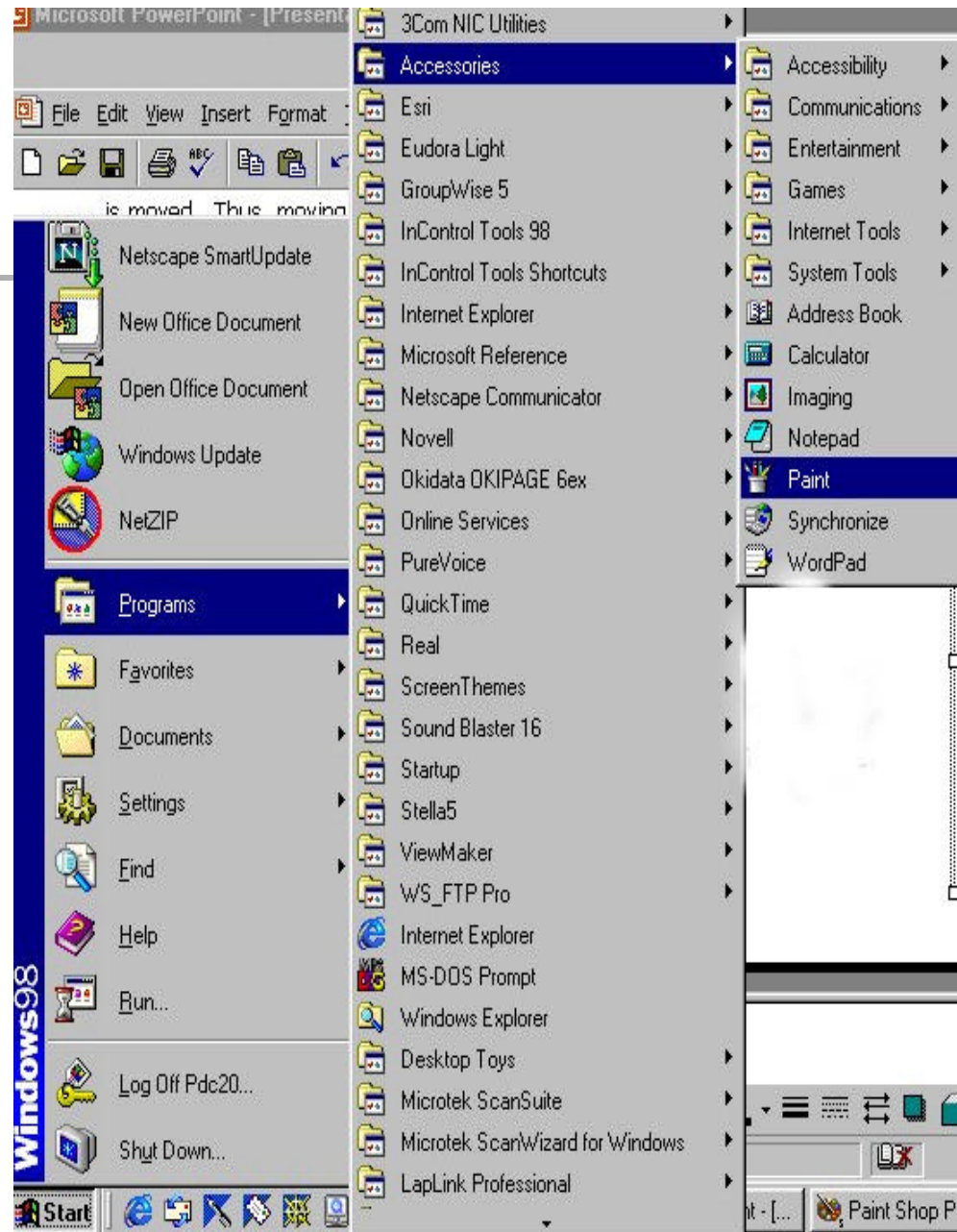
Opening the Paint Program...

- Move the mouse to "Programs".



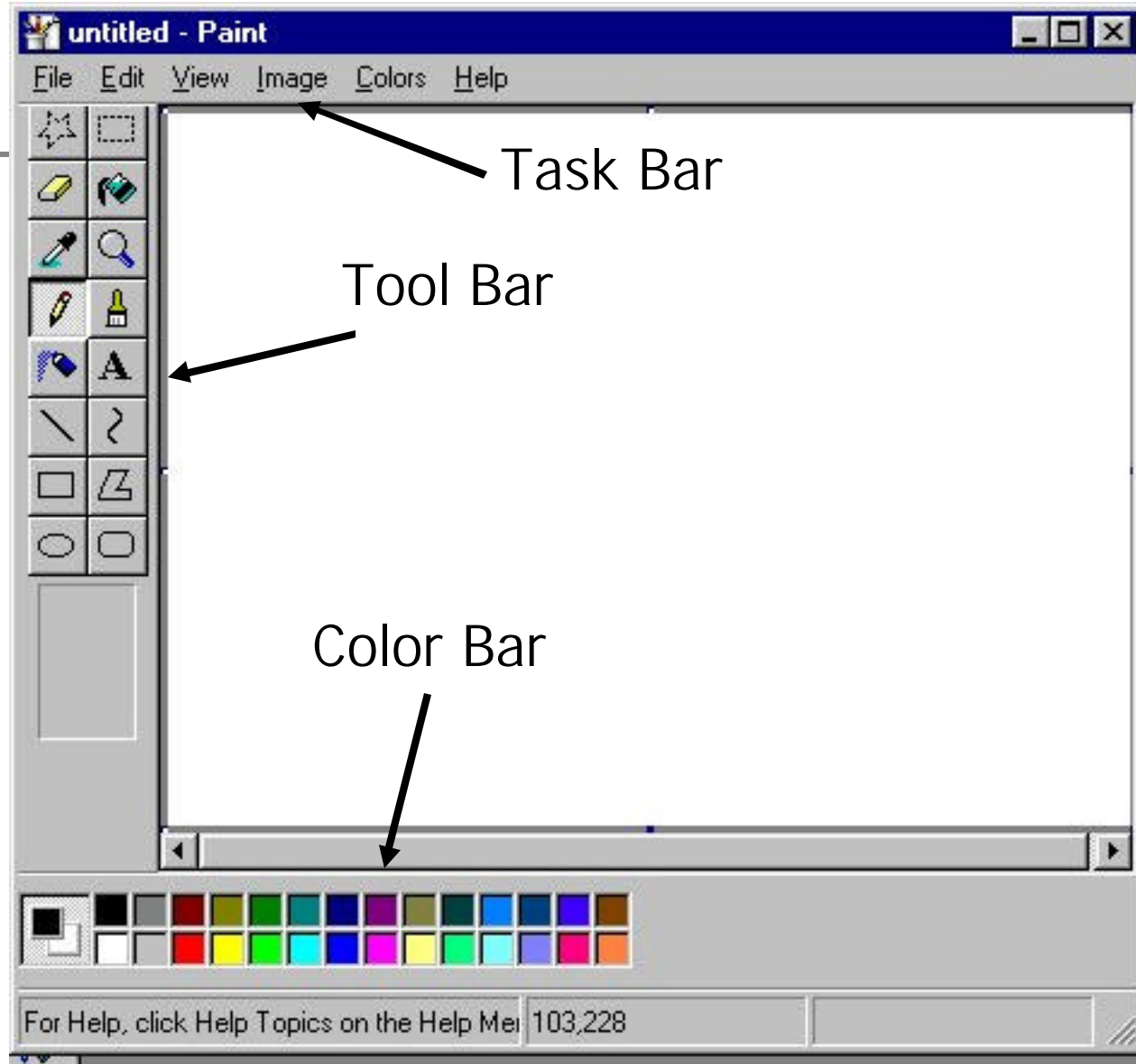

- Move the mouse from “accessories” to “paint”, left click.



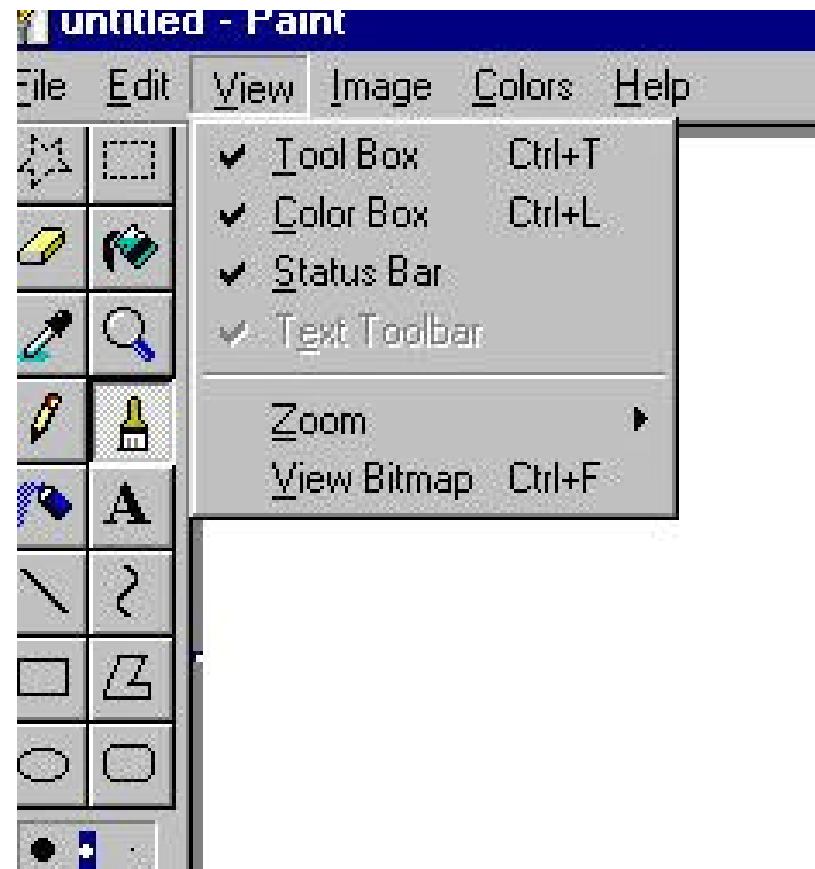
Welcome to Paint!

- Your screen will look like this.



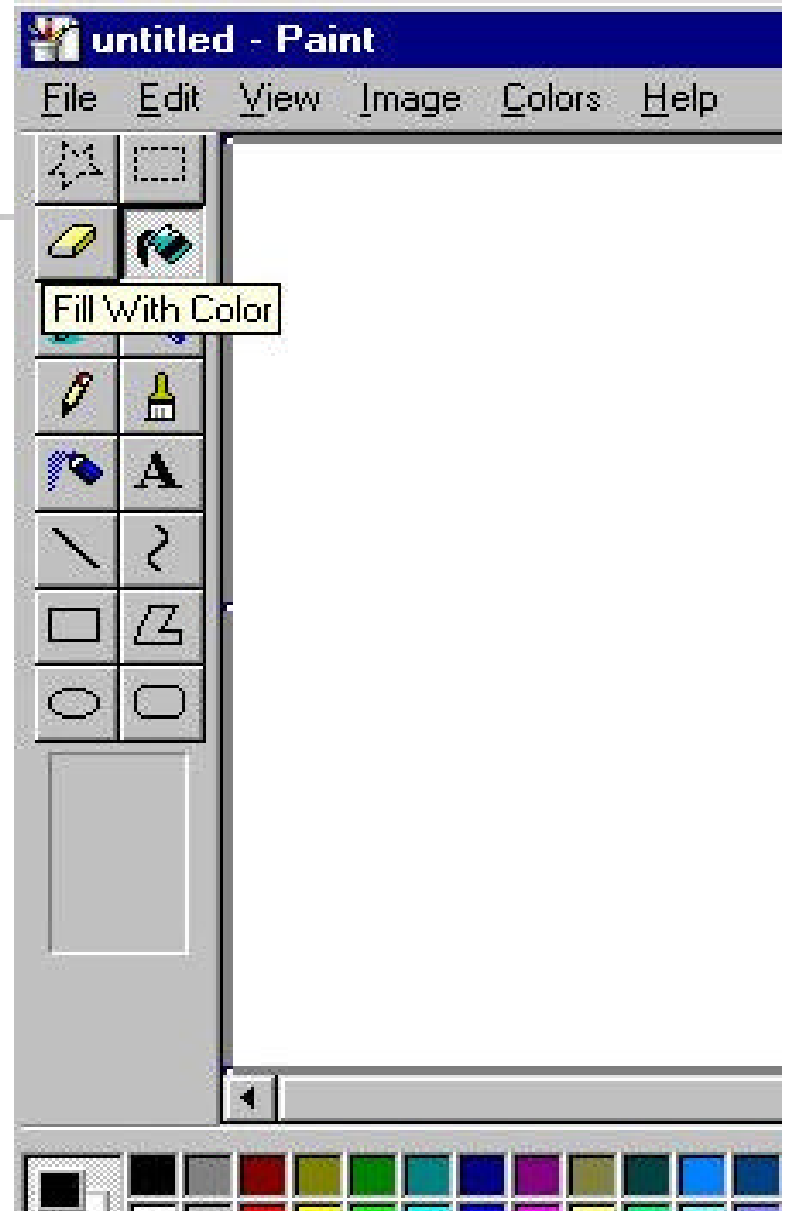
Double Check

- Left click "View" on task bar and make sure that Tool, Color, and Status Boxes are checked.



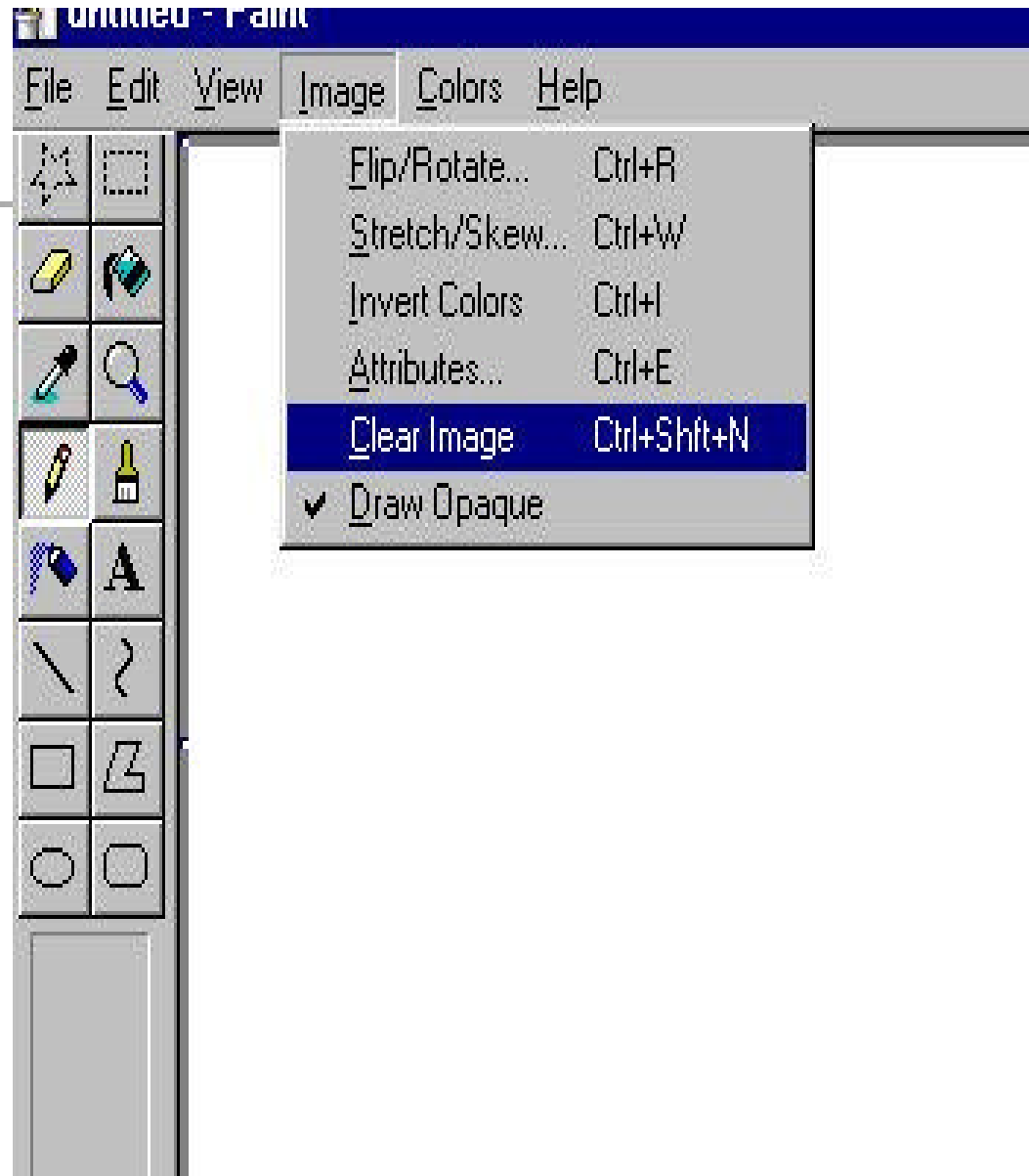
Selecting the tool!

- A label window will appear.



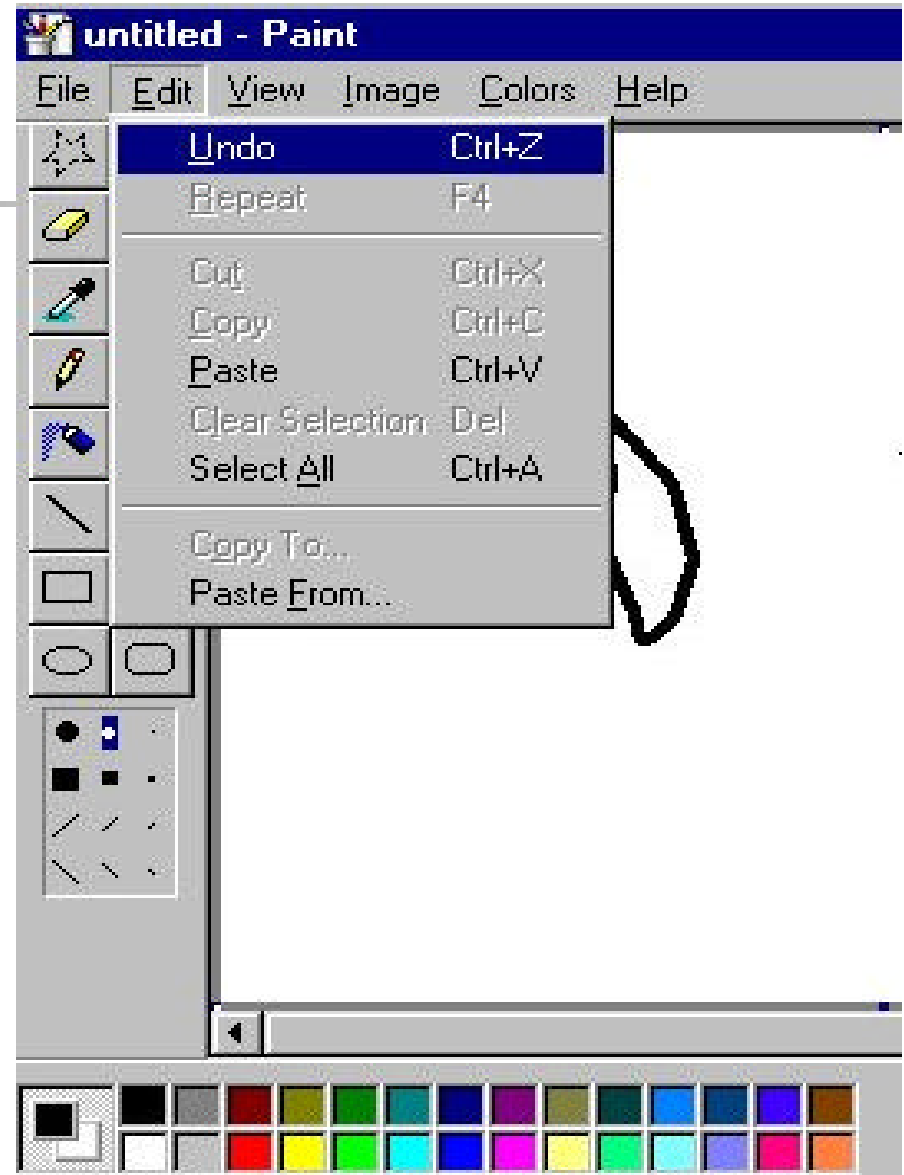
Paint tips!

- Correcting mistakes.

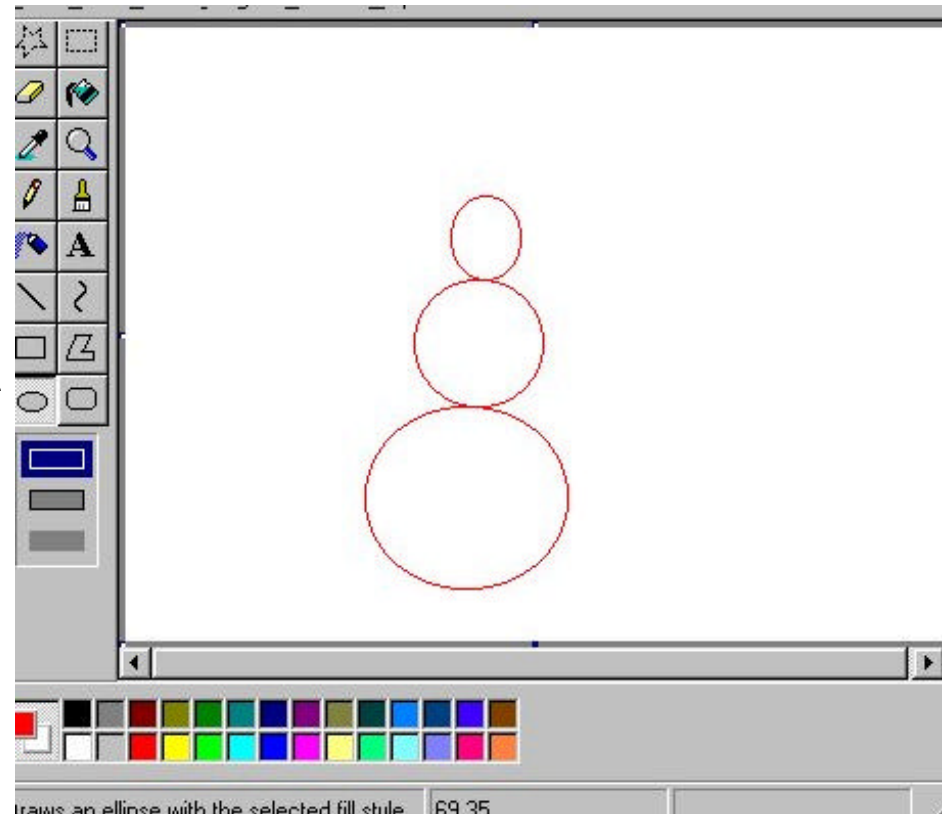
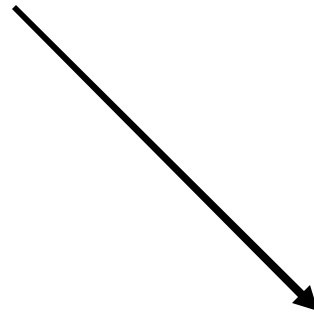

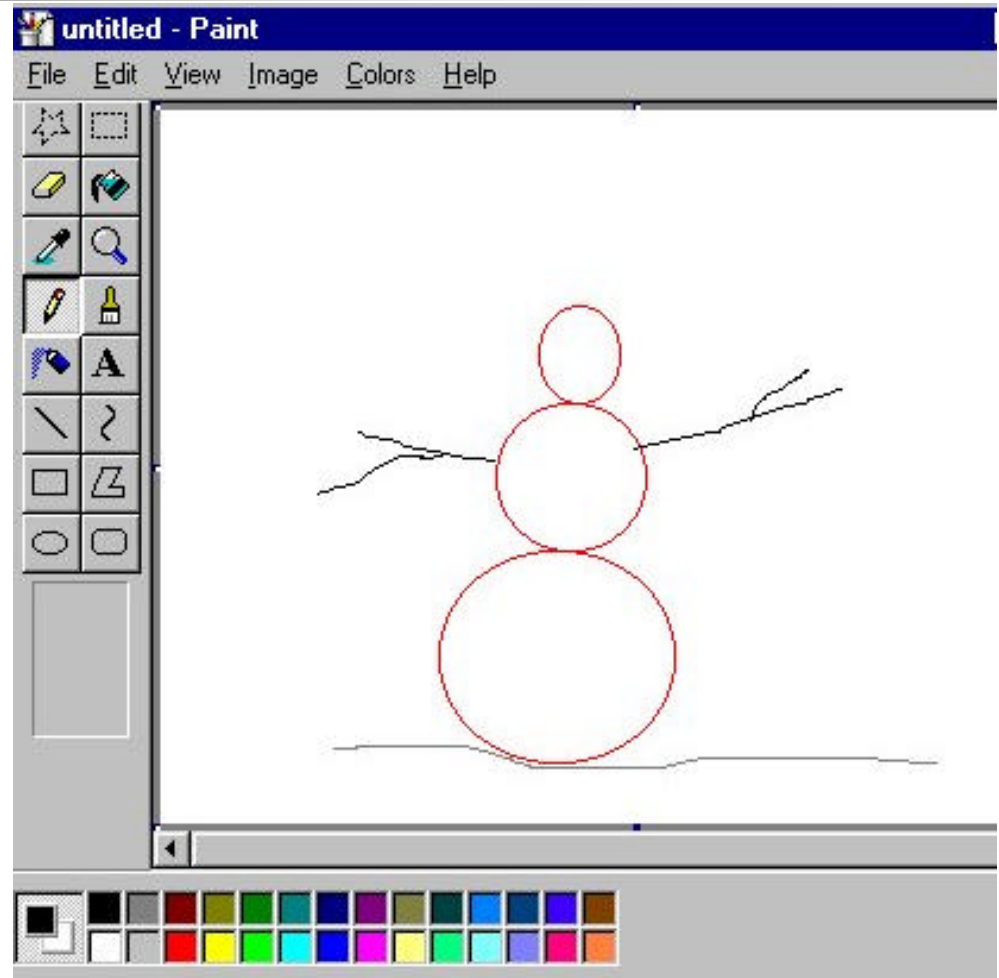
Let's make a snowman!

- Using the oval tool.



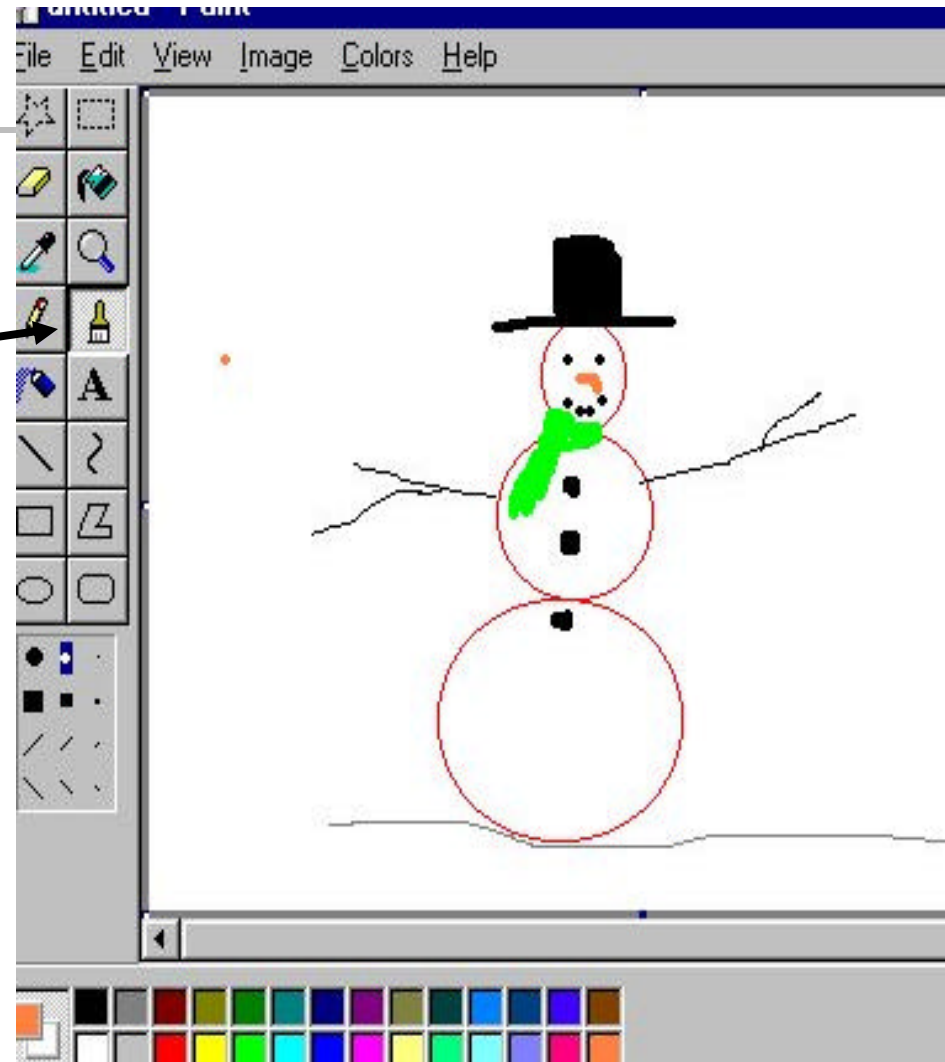
Arms and snow!

- Using the pencil tool.



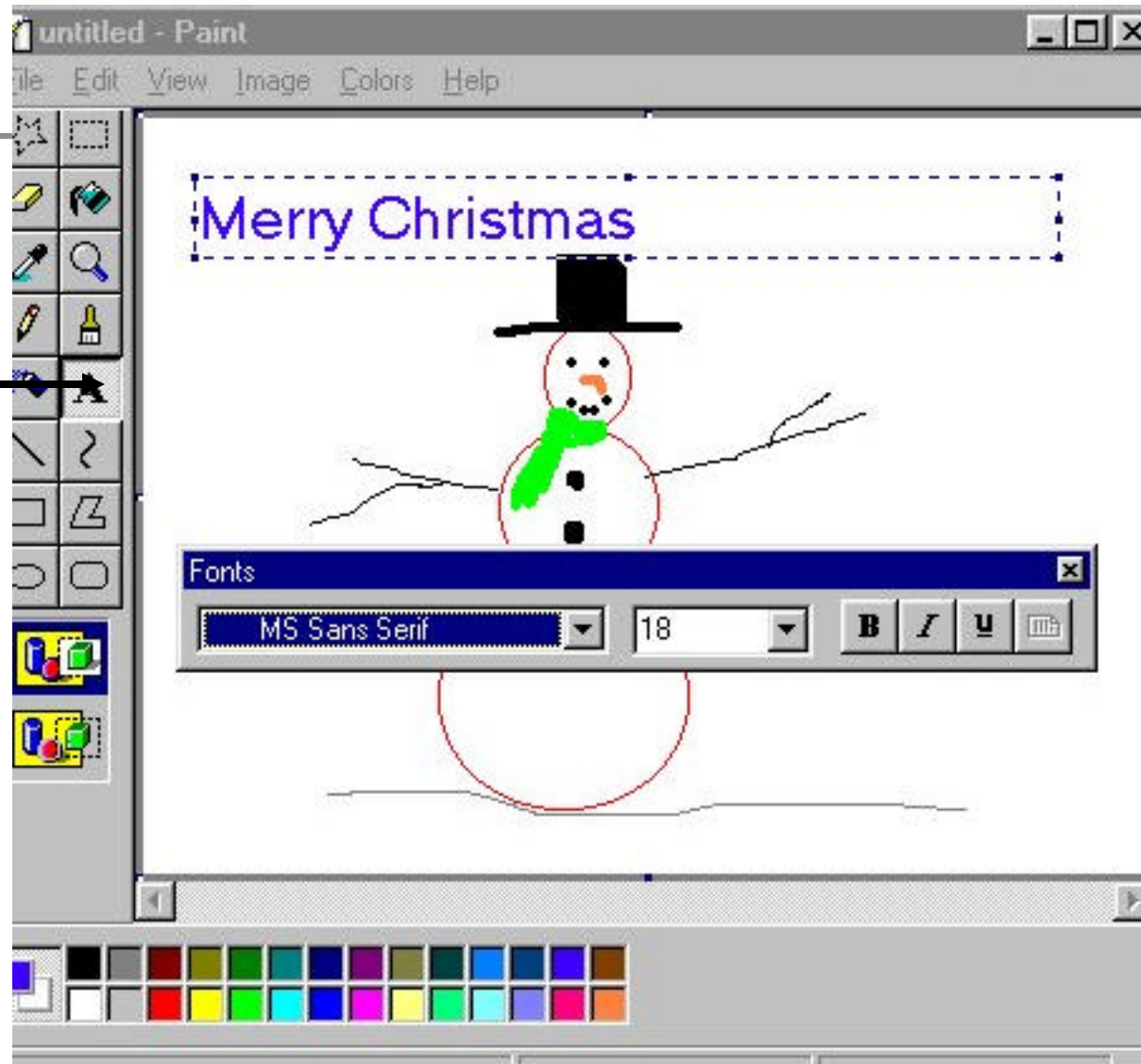
Snowman Accessories!

- Using the tools provided, create this picture.

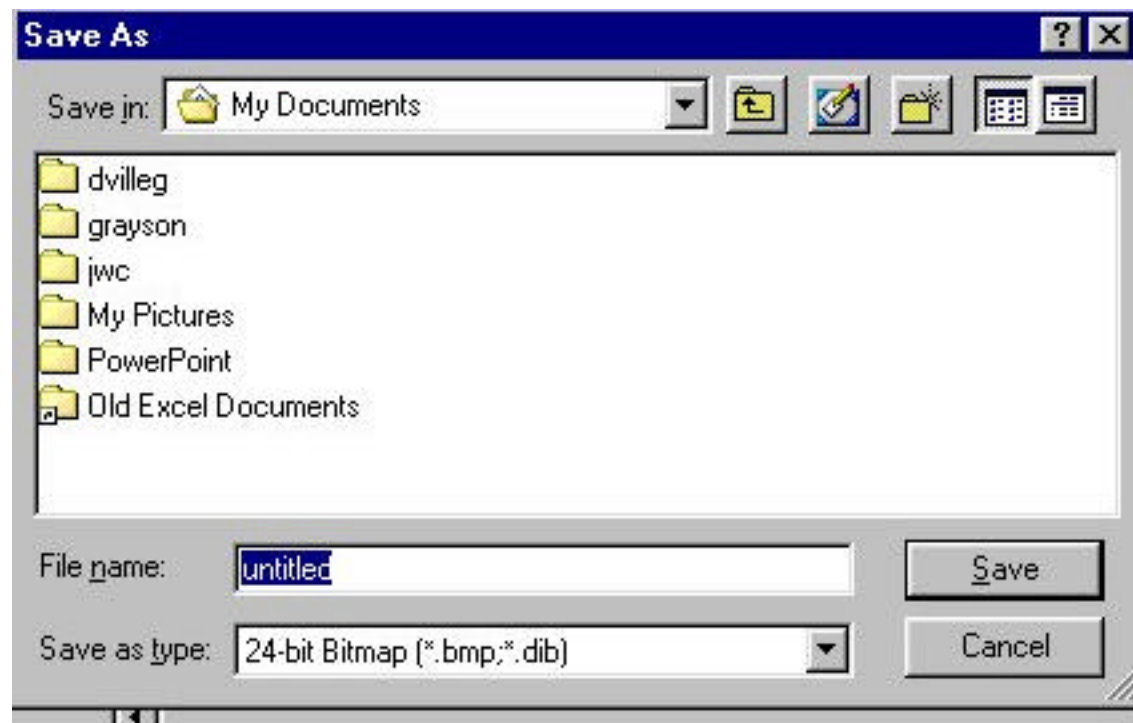


Saving your masterpiece!

- Saving to “My Documents”.

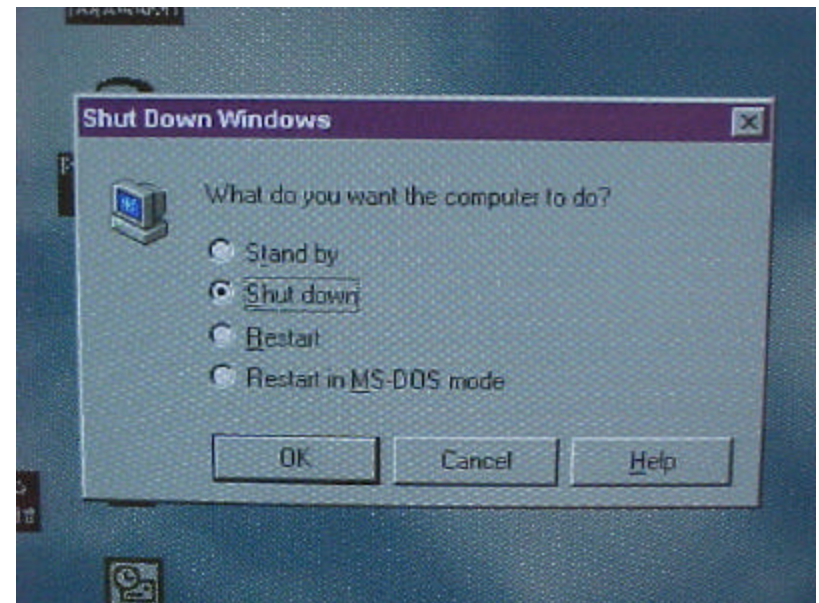


- Naming your file.
