- Our School Improvement Plan targets three areas: reading, writing, and mathematics. We have made progress in improving student performance in these areas for the past three years. We made Adequate Yearly Progress in 2004 and 2005. Preliminary results for Spring 2006 indicate that we made Adequate Yearly Progress again.
- State Assessments for Spring 2006 indicate the following:
 - Reading: 69.5% of third graders at/above proficient
52% of fourth graders at/above proficient
65% of fifth graders at/above proficient
 - Math: 82.6% of third graders at/above proficient
48% of fourth graders at/above proficient
65% of fifth graders at/above proficient
- Our 2006-07 School Improvement Plan will continue to focus on improving student achievement in reading and math. We will work on developing students' thinking skills, through a focus on reading comprehension skills/vocabulary development and conceptual understanding and problem solving skills in math.
