## KANSAS STATE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION DOCUMENTATION OF PRIVATE SCHOOL CONSULTATION

**P.L. 107-110 No Child Left Behind requires that consultation occur between the local education agency and private school officials.**

Consultation should be ongoing, and the following topics should be discussed before any decisions are made:

- Method/source of data used to determine the number of children from low income families in participating attendance areas who attend private school
- How the specific needs of eligible children will be identified
- Types of services that will be offered to meet those needs
- How, where and by whom services will be provided
- When and how often services will be provided
- How and when the decision will be made in regard to the delivery of services
- How services will be academically assessed
- How results from the assessment will improve services
- The proportion of funds that will be allocated to provide such services
- If the private school wants services provided through a contractor and the local education agency chooses not to use that contractor, the local education agency has provided the private school a written analysis of the reasons.


We agree that timely and meaningful consultation with appropriate private school officials occurred before the local education agency made decisions that affected the participation of eligible private school children in the following Title program services: Title I A, Title II A, Title II D, Title III, Title IV, Title V and Migrant.

In 2007-08, the private school will participate in the following programs:

- Title I (Improving the Academic Achievement of Disadvantaged Children)
- Title II A (Teacher and Principal Training and Recruiting)
- Title II D (Enhancing Education Through Technology)
- Title III (Language Instruction for Limited English Proficient and Immigrant Students)
- Title IV (Safe and Drug-Free Schools and Communities)
- Title V (Innovative Programs)
- Migrant
