We are excited to report that school library materials budgets for 2007-2008 are increasing to \$7.50 per student. Library supply budgets are allocated at \$1.05 per student. Attached is a list of the allocated budgets for library materials and for library supplies for each school.

Budgets are based on the projected school enrollment figures that we received in early August 2007. We do not adjust the budget figures for official enrollment figures in September.
