Preschool Enrollment For 4 year olds as of 8/31/12

A free half-day preschool program for 4 year olds is available at district sites. The program will help develop the skills needed to begin school ready to learn. Students will be eligible if they meet **one or more** of the following criteria designated by the State of Kansas:

- **Single parent family** (custodial parent is unmarried)
- **Income guidelines for free meal by 9/20/12**
- **SRS referral** (letter stating child would benefit from preschool)
- **Parent without a high school diploma or GED**
- **Developmental delays** documented by assessments set up KSDE requirements
- **Teen parent** (when child was born)
- **English Language Learners**
- **Migrant Status**

Transportation will be provided

Breakfast – available for the morning session
Lunch – available for the afternoon session
