



Dive...into a book for spring reading and then into the water at Schlitterbahn this summer!

What do I need to do? Log all the pages that you read from December 18, 2009 (the beginning of winter break) until April 15, 2010. All logs must be turned in to your school librarian before you go home on April 15.

How many pages do I need to read?

Preschool and Elementary students need to read a minimum of 1,500 pages or listen as books are read aloud.

Middle School, High School, and Alternative School students need to read a minimum of 3,000 pages.

All students need to log their pages read just like we do for summer reading. Turn your reading logs in to your school librarian or library assistant.

What are the prizes?

- ❖ **Each student** who reads the required number of pages (or more) and turns in his/her reading log will receive a Buy-One-Get-One-Free coupon from Schlitterbahn good for 4 people.
- ❖ **Each school** who has at least one student read the required number of pages and submit a reading log will receive a pair of tickets for full-day admission to Schlitterbahn Waterpark. School winners will be chosen by drawing names from the readers who qualify at each school site. Additional tickets will be distributed to schools based upon the number of readers achieving the reading goals.
- ❖ **Each instructional level** (preschool, elementary, middle, and high) will receive a pair of season passports to Schlitterbahn Waterpark. Numbers of season tickets available at each level were determined by enrollment. These winners will be chosen by a drawing.
