School Highlights

- All 1st graders participated in an additional 45 minutes of reading instruction in small groups four days a week.
- 5th grade attended Starbase Academy for 5 weeks this year. They learned scientific concepts through cooperative learning and authentic experiences.
- Emerson is involved in the community. Students walked in the Silver City Day Parade. Classes routinely pick up trash in Emerson Park. Emerson participated in Jump Rope for Heart, collected canned goods for Crosslines and collected pop tabs to donate to the Ronald McDonald House.
- All 3rd-5th graders presented small group projects using the Scientific Method for our Science Fair. Kindergarten, 1st and 2nd grade classes submitted whole class projects.
- Emerson had before and after school care available through Kidzone. Morning Kidzone was held at Emerson for our students and students from four other elementary schools. In the afternoon, Emerson students went to another school for Kidzone.
- Emerson partnered with Gear Up. Participating 2nd-5th grade students met once a week during lunch for extra instruction and encouragement. Fifth graders were provided tutoring.
- Family Nights focused on reading, math, science and physical education. During these nights, Emerson families come to the school to learn ways to help their children with the academic subject at home.
- Parent Involvement is increasing at Emerson. PTA sponsored many events for students and teachers including holiday parties, Santa's Secret Shop, P.E./Nutrition Night, and the Spring Carnival. Site Council met monthly.
- Students enjoyed assemblies such as various Arts Partners programs — Alvin Ailey Dance and Kansas Cultural History. Field trips were taken to several educational locations around the City. The Nelson Art Gallery, Kaleidoscope and Deanna Rose Farmstead were a few of our destinations as well as walking field trips to the nearby fire station and post office.
- Fifth grade students had the opportunity to participate in a monthly "Chat-n-Chew". Each month, students read the same book. During a lunchtime, they got together in small groups to discuss the book and eat pizza.
- Emerson has many great students! Each month an assembly was held to recognize a "Terrific Kid" and a "Student of the Month" from each classroom. The criteria for this included using good manners, doing class work and homework and working hard. In addition, Students of the Month also had high academic achievement. Each Student of the Month received a t-shirt and had their picture on the bulletin board.
- Throughout the year, many students participated in our Fall and Spring Reading Achievers. Students were awarded prizes and an ice cream sundae for reading and keeping a reading log.

- Safety and student well-being is a priority for Emerson. First graders were taught to dial 911 using a simulator. Tornado, fire, and intruder drills are practiced routinely.
- The Reading is Fundamental (RIF) Program allowed students the opportunity to add to personal libraries from a book distribution that was offered.
- The Student Improvement Teams (SIT) met weekly to ensure the academic and behavioral success for all students.
- Intermediate students had the opportunity to help Emerson through our Student Council.
- Emerson is a Positive Behavior Support (PBS) school. Our students with excellent behavior attended monthly behavior parties. Our behavior parties included activities such as going bowling, making ice cream sundaes and making valentines. Good behavior in the lunchroom was also rewarded. The class with the best behavior won the Lunchroom Etiquette Award and received five minutes of extra recess. After five, ten and fifteen Awards were earned, classes received a popcorn party, a special table in the lunchroom and a lunch at a restaurant respectively.
- Emerson used NWEA-MAP testing in reading and math to assess our students' growth. The data from the assessments was also used to help teachers plan instruction.
- Emerson students and families read over the summer. Families participated in our Summer Reading Program and came to Emerson three times over the summer to "check-in". We had fun talking about reading and eating dinner, desserts or watermelon.
- Emerson provided after school tutoring in reading and math for students.
- After school activities for students included The Good News Club and Girl Scouts.
