School Highlights

- **English as a Second Language** — Our ESL population has grown to 60%. The majority of our staff completed their second ESL course through Kansas State University. They are working toward their ESL endorsement and will begin the third course in the fall of '08. The course is being taught by our principal who has over 20 years of experience in ESL. We have a full time ESL teacher who spends the majority of her time collaborating with our teachers and co-teaching in the classroom.
- **School Improvement Team** — The SIT team met regularly to discuss the academic and behavior needs of our students. The team looked at classroom interventions to help the students who were recommended to make more progress in the classroom.
- **RIF** — The Reading is Fundamental Program gives students the opportunity to receive books. Books are also made available in Spanish for our ELL students. Students received books in May so that they could begin on their summer reading.
- Mark Twain's **PTA worked very hard this year**. Many projects were completed, including a "Flap Jack" dinner, school calendars, an end of the year skating party and a Cinco de Mayo celebration that included professional dancers as well as Mark Twain's own students performing folkloric dances and a "Mexican" pot luck dinner. PTA encourages community involvement and helps raise money for our school.
- Mark Twain is working with the **Urban Scholastic Center under the direction of Chuck Allen**. Mr. Allen is working on a weekly basis with our older students in the areas of character building and making wise choices. The Urban Scholastic Center held after school tutoring for our 4th and 5th grade students on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays.
- Mark Twain did not have the minimum percent of students scoring at the proficient level to meet the state's criterion for "adequate yearly progress." Mark Twain offered an **after school tutoring program** to increase student achievement. Tutoring was provided in math and reading twice per week for students in grades 2-5.
- **PBS** — Mark Twain became a PBS school last year and we are continuing to implement the Positive Behavior Support program as a school-wide program.
- Mark Twain is piloting a **uniform program**. We have a large percentage of students who are participating on a volunteer basis.
- **Score 1** provided health screenings for the students at Mark Twain. The screenings resulted in students getting necessary health and dental assistance. The Principal was invited to become a member of the Advisory Council of Score 1 and will serve for two years.

Mission Statement

To have every child reading at or above grade level by third grade with no regressions thereafter and to provide the educational foundation for students to become self-reliant, life-long learners.
