School Highlights

- New Stanley made Adequate Yearly Progress in all of its subgroups in reading and math.
- New Stanley maintained an extended year calendar to meet the needs of all of their students.
- McDonald's at 42nd and Kansas Avenue adopted our school and we participated in monthly McTeacher Nights. Staff and PTA members served as greeters to our families and other patrons on those nights. The restaurant donated a percentage of the sales to the school.
- Our Small Learning Communities worked this past year on activities to improve relationships and students' academic performance. The Incredibles, Scholars, and Gap Zappers planned activities which incorporated learning with fun activities.
- Reading for pleasure and problem solving were the focus of our monthly family literacy nights.
- As part of their commitment to the community, students raised over \$700 for United Way; over \$1,000 for Jump Rope for Heart; and donated canned goods to Harvesters and Crosslines.
- Marianne Murphy, a second grade teacher, was selected as New Stanley's 2009 Teacher of the Year.
- Laura Cuddy, a third grade teacher, was selected as Kansas City Kansas Elementary Horizon Teacher of the Year.
- Many students' artwork was selected for the KCK Public Schools Beyond the Classroom display. New Stanley artwork was also displayed at the Kansas State Board of Education building. Several students from New Stanley had their artwork on display at Pearson Hall at KU.
- All students participated in the New Stanley Science Fair with experiments using the scientific method.
- New Stanley students recognized members of the community throughout various times of the year by making cards, ornaments, artwork, posters, banners as well as participating in the Silver City Parade.
- More technology was introduced in the building to students to ensure student success and increased engagement and motivation.
- New Stanley had a career fair involving community members, business partners as well as friends and family of staff and students to share their expertise about their career.
- New Stanley continued as a Professional Development School. Working with the University of Kansas, New Stanley collaborated with interns and student teachers from KU in their classrooms throughout the year.
- Home visits to students' homes by teachers took place at the beginning of the school year. Teachers introduced themselves to each student's parents and started building school to home relationships.
- English as a Second Language students made at least one year's growth in their language scores.

- A William Allen White Book Club for third, fourth, and fifth graders met during the school year. Students read, reviewed, and voted on their favorite books.
- The Home/School Bookbag Program, designed by the ESL Teacher and Librarian, was focused on math and science. Each bookbag contained a book to be read and supplemental activities for the parent and child to complete. These were available in English and Spanish.
- New Stanley students and staff participated in a Spirit Day by sending positive messages to other classes and the community.
