Beginning January 1, 2008:

When turning in the green timesheet to Federal Programs at the Education Center for payment from Title I and or General Fund Replacement funds, stipends must be paid from specific categories. Those categories are as follows:

- Curriculum
- Intercession
- Lunch Room Monitor
- Parent Involvement
- Security – Security Guard
- Security - Metal Detectors (Certified staff)
- Security – Metal Detectors (Classified staff)
- Staff Development
- Technical Training
- Tutoring

The above categories must be designated (filled in) under the Activity column on the green timesheet. Other activity descriptions will not be accepted. This will help us make sure that the timesheets being paid for under Title I and GFR funds are being coded in the appropriate categories.

Note: If Security Guards are being used for support of the SES Program at your building, the security should be paid for by the outside provider, not the building. Your Title I funds should not be used for this security service. However, in order to do this, you will need to speak with the provider who will be responsible for the security guard. You cannot contract the guard for duty and then bill the provider. The provider must be aware of this and willing to do this.
