

## **Viewpoint-MN: Report Descriptions**

All report results are based on the “selector” criteria, which can be district, school, grade, teacher, course, section, period, student or student grouping and combinations of these selections for a selected school year.

Additionally, Student Enrollment Status filter and filter the report results based on active, inactive/withdrawn and all students.

Dynamic Student Grouping can be applied to also filter the reports to a subset of a demographic population.

Reports and charts/graphs allow drill down from summarized or group information to a lower level of detailed records to student electronic cumulative reports.

Assessment reports contain as many detail elements as are available for that particular assessment from vendors or districts. Although the reports are generic and apply to all assessments, the report results will vary from assessment to assessment based on the detail elements available.

User security rights can restrict/permit access to reports, report sections, and report columns.

## **Demographic Reports**

*Student Demographic Explorer* – Report of students with “demographics” of your choosing.

*Demographic Breakdown* – This report is based on the drop down demographic selection and will display a graphical representation of your selected population based on demographic attribute.

NOTE: Any or all of these demographic selection reports can also be posted as individual reports.

*Demographic Comparison* – This report is like Demographic Breakdown with two graphs, comparing your selected population against a higher level.

## **NCLB/AYP Reports**

*Scores by Demographics* – This report provides disaggregation by demographic attribute revealing participation counts, percents, means, medians scores and more

*NCLB Categories* – This report displays percents and counts by one NCLB category for proficient/not proficient assessment results.

*NCLB 2 By 2* - This report displays percents and counts for two NCLB category groups (i.e. LEP and ethnicity) on proficient/not proficient assessment results.

*NCLB Side by Side Comparison* - This report displays percents and counts for two NCLB category groups side by side (i.e. LEP and ethnicity) on proficient/not proficient assessment results.

*AYP Summary* – This grade level report compares state, district, and school average subject and strand assessment results for each AYP student demographic grouping.

## **Growth Reports**

*MAP Growth Report* – This report displays growth information for MAP assessments.

*MAP Growth vs Proficiency Report* – This report displays growth and proficiency information for MAP assessments.

## **Assessment Reports**

Test Performance – Achievement/Proficiency-focused reports that are graphical with drillthrough to assessment details for students.

Test Performance Comparison – This report is similar to *Test Performance* with two graphs, comparing your selected population against a higher level. The higher level graph is not drillable to honor security restrictions.

(BST) Graduation Requirement – This report tracks graduation assessment requirements for students based on graduation year. Currently this is a BST report. For Fall 2008 there will also be a GRAD version of this report.

Scores by Percent/Percentile – This graphical report provides details at assessment levels assigned Percent correct or Percentile rankings.

Test Statistics – This report provides statistical information for your assessments including means, median, ranges, interquartile ranges, standard deviations and more.

Scores by Season/Sequence – These reports provide a longitudinal view of assessment results given at regular intervals (seasons) for all students, or irregular intervals (sequence) for students. Color-coded achievement/proficiency levels provide quick interpretation of trends.

Scores by Subject and Strand – This report provides details on subject and strand level scores.

Student Scores Explorer – This report allows a detailed view of all data elements available at each assessment level (subject, strand/standard, substrand/benchmark, etc.).

Score Comparison Explorer – This report allows comparison of “selector” criteria to comparable groupings at the same school and then to all schools at that level (i.e., elementary, jr high/middle, high school, alternative center, etc.), and to district wide.

Scatter Plot - This graph allows the comparison of two assessments. It provides information on correlation coefficient and other statistical details. Each point delivers hover text and drill through to student cumulative file.

Test Triangulation – This report compares “most recent” assessment scores of a subject type side by side along with demographic data. Empty cells reveal students that haven’t been tested.

Test Distribution – This report shows a graphical/grid representation of assessment results grouped by score bands. It shows the distribution of your students on the assessments and it allows easy identification of students “on the bubble” as well as proficient and non-proficient students. This includes assessment information at all levels, such as subject, strand, substrand. If available rubric information can be linked to this report to provide important instructional information.

## **Grade Reports**

Grades by Course – This graphical report displays breakdown of course grades/marks for a course, or section with drillthrough to grade detail for students.

Grades vs Assessments – This graphical report displays assessment achievement/proficiency results by course grades/marks allowing you to analyze the alignment of your curriculum, correlation of course grades/marks to assessment results and easy identification of students where course grades/marks and assessment results are inconsistent.

Grades Distribution by Term – This report provides a count of the occurrences of grades by term. These counts can be drilled into to get a report of the students and classes in which the grades were given.

Student Summary - This section displays student name, school, id, birthdate, grade demographics of districts choosing, GPA(s), address and more.

Student Schedule – This section displays the student’s class schedules, partitioned by term and toggleable by year.

Student Test Results – This section displays assessment results partitioned by National Tests, State Tests, District/Local Tests.

Student Test Summary – This section displays summarized assessment results with subject level information and proficiencies. This is a great historic assessment report that educators often print and share with parents at conferences.

Student Cumulative Credit Summary – This section displays the student’s cumulative credit balance of credits earned, attempted and remaining.

Student Course History - This section displays student’s course grade/mark history including credits details.

Student Enrollment History – This section displays the student’s enrollment history during their academic career.

Student MARSS Enrollment History – This section displays the student’s enrollment history during their academic career including each MARSS change detail.

Student Absences - This section displays the student’s absence and tardy details.

Student Disciplinary Incidents – This section displays the student’s disciplinary incidents.

*Student Medical* – This section displays two subsections with the 1) Immunization and 2) Health concerns for the student

*Student Activities* – This section displays the student's activities details.
